NTEGRATOR WINS FOUR NEW CONTRACTS WORTH S\$16.7 MILLION

- **Expansion of customer base with maiden contract win from Telekomunikasi Indonesia**
- **Another three contracts awarded by Viettel Corporation and its subsidiary in Cambodia**
- **Total outstanding order book increases to S\$69.9 million**

Singapore, June 2, 2009 – Ntegrator International Ltd (“Ntegrator” or “the Group”), a leading regional communications network specialist and systems integrator, today announced that it has won a maiden contract from Telekomunikasi Indonesia International Pte Ltd (“Telkom”), a subsidiary of Indonesia’s largest full information and communications service and network provider, PT Telekomunikasi Indonesia Tbk. Another three contracts were clinched from Vietnam’s largest telco operator, Viettel Corporation (“Viettel”) and its subsidiary in Cambodia, Viettel Cambodia.

With the award of these four new contracts worth a total of S\$16.7 million, the Group’s total outstanding order book has increased to S\$69.9 million, a significant portion of which are expected to be completed this year. This is a commendable improvement over its FY2008 performance when the Group recorded total revenue of S\$47.9 million for the year ended December 31, 2008.

Under the terms of the Telkom contract, Ntegrator will be supporting Telkom’s new network initiative for the provision of international telecommunication bandwidth in the region through the supply and installation of MMR Cables and Trays in Singapore.

Said Mr Jimmy Chang, Managing Director of Ntegrator: "Telkom joins our portfolio of well-established customers in the region, which includes SingTel, Singapore's leading telco operator, and Viettel, Vietnam's largest telco operator. We look forward to building a strong and lasting relationship with Telkom."

The three new contracts from Viettel and Viettel Cambodia follow closely on last month's four new contracts worth S\$20.9 million from Viettel, SingTel and the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore.

Continued Mr Chang: "We enjoy a strong and mutually-beneficial working relationship with Viettel since Ntegrator was established in 2002. Over the past seven years, we have received continuing repeat orders from Viettel, showcasing the high level of confidence and customer satisfaction that Viettel Corporation has in the quality of our products and customised solutions."

Under the terms of the contract awarded by Viettel Cambodia, Ntegrator will provide infrastructure expansion for the Synchronous Digital Hierarchy ("SDH") infrastructure, which the Group supplied and installed under the maiden contract clinched from Viettel Cambodia in May last year.

The other two contracts clinched from Viettel will cover the expansion of the Dense Wavelength Division Multiplexing system, an optical technology used to increase bandwidth over existing fibre optic backbones, and the IP Router for Viettel in Vietnam.

All the four contracts are expected to have a positive impact on the earnings of the Group for FY2009.
